DIVING TORCH TECLINE US-13

INSTRUCTION MANUAL

PURPOSE

The Tecline US-13 diving torch is designed for underwater use as a backup light.

Thanks to a special heat sink that allows operation above water, also serves as a durable torch for home and car use.



USE / CHARGING THE BATTERY

Battery Installation

- Unscrew the torch head by turning it counter clockwise.
- Remove the used batteries and replace them with new ones, inserting them into the compartment according to the polarity label. showing + / -.
- Screw the head back on clockwise until the torch turns on. Then unscrew the head by a ¼ turn until the light turns off.
- You can use an 18650 rechargeable battery for power, which requires the adapter included with the flashlight.

Turning On/Off

To turn on the torch, screw the head clockwise until the light comes on. Do not overtighten the head to avoid damaging the O-rings between the head and the body.

WARNING: Do not use any tools to tighten the head!

To turn off the torch, gently unscrew the head counterclockwise until the light turns off.

WARNING: Do not unscrew the head too much, as this may cause water to enter the torch.

SAFETY INFORMATION / RECOMMENDATIONS FOR THE BATTERY

- !) Never point the light beam directly at the eyes. The torch beam can cause permanent eye damage.
 - !) Avoid using the torch on the surface. Overheating may damage the LED.
 - !) Never open the battery compartment or fully unscrew the head underwater — this may flood the battery chamber and damage the torch and batteries. Such damage is not covered by the warranty.
 - !) If the torch does not turn on or the light is weak, replace the batteries. Always use new batteries.
- Do not mix old and new batteries.

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WARNING!

THIS TORCH IS DESIGNED TO OPERATE ONLY WITH 1.5V AAA BATTERIES OR 1.2V RECHARGEABLE BATTERIES.

USING ANY OTHER POWER SOURCE MAY DAMAGE THE TORCH AND SUCH DAMAGE IS NOT COVERED BY THE WARRANTY.

MAINTENANCE AND STORAGE

- The torch should be thoroughly rinsed with clean fresh water after each use.
- All O-rings should be replaced every 12 months.
- If the O-rings are too loose, they must be replaced.
- O-rings should be lightly lubricated with silicone grease designed for O-rings.
- The torch should be stored in a dry place at room temperature.

TECHNICAL DATA

- Light source: Cree XML U2 LED, white light
- LED lifespan: approximately 100,000 h
- Power: 8W, 800 lm
- Beam angle: 10°
- Color temperature: 6000K–7000K
- Power supply: 3 x AAA batteries (batteries are not included)
- Material: anodized aluminum
- Head: ultra-clear tempered glass lens and aluminum reflector maintaining a precise 10° beam
- Waterproof rating: 200 m (IP68)
- Runtime: approximately 2.0 h
- Dimensions: 132 mm x 42 mm (head) x 30 mm (body)
- Weight: 180 g without batteries
- O-rings: 27x2 mm

Note: All specifications were measured in laboratory conditions in accordance with ANSI/NEMA FL1 flashlight testing standards. The values are approximate and may vary between different flashlights, batteries, or environments.

WARRANTY

The product is guaranteed for two years from the date of purchase and is only valid with proof of purchase from the Scubatech/Tecline shop. The guarantee does not cover:

- loss or damage caused by improper use of the torch (including use in chlorinated water without first protecting the torch),
- visual damage caused by intensive use of the torch (scratches on the outer shell),
- damage caused by excessive heat or chemical damage,
- overheating caused by using the torch on a surface for too long,
- damage caused by improper maintenance, storage or unauthorised repairs.

UTILISATION

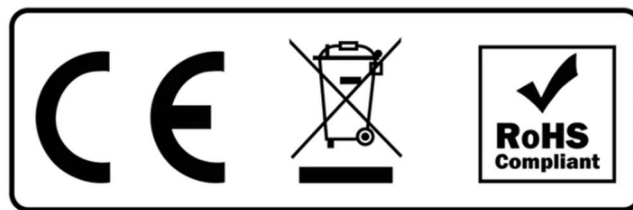
